During the final exam period, on weeknights without a final exam, the latest a student may start an exam is 12:30 pm. Students may also schedule deferment exams when exams in other courses are held. Students may NOT take an exam when the office is closed. Check the Academic Calendar on our website for office closings and final exam schedules.

REASON FOR THE DEFERRED EXAMINATION:

NOTE: All exams must be taken within seven (7) days of the original exam date unless an extended examination date is authorized by the Dean or Assistant Dean for extraordinary reasons. In an extraordinary case, the delayed or makeup exam shall be completed within thirty (30) days of the date of the exam. Failure to complete a delayed or extended exam within the prescribed deadlines will result in an automatic grade of “F” for all affected courses.
